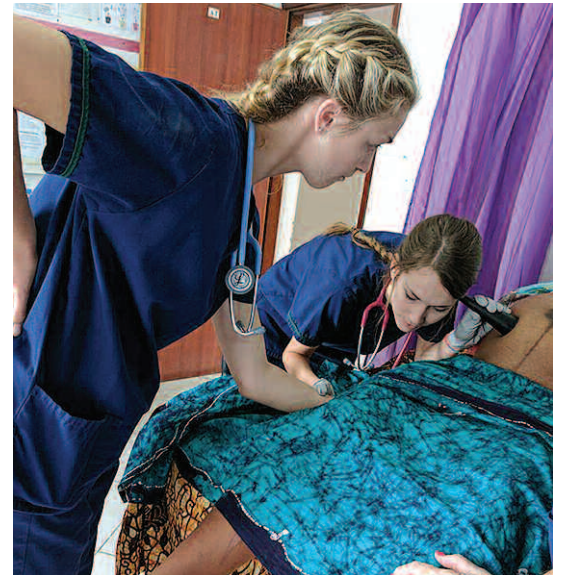

Understand health needs of children and adolescents, including those related to school health while examining strategies for identification, management, client/family education, and referral in this cultural rich setting. See for yourself the health deviations common to women and lifespan concerns/transitions of women, including the pre- and postnatal experience and crises experienced uniquely by women. Explore the Tanzanian health care system with intensive placements and educational workshops. Airfare, accommodations in hotels with some camping, planned excursions, and most meals are included in the program cost.
