- » The UIMP was founded by Spain's Ministry of Education in 1932 under the name Universidad de Santander. In 1945 it acquired its present title. An autonomous institution that is accredited by Spain's Ministry of Education and Science, the UIMP continues to have its central campus in the city of Santander, where it originated. In the city of Sevilla, ISA has partnered with the UIMP to expand the UIMP's course offerings in language, culture and business with courses offered in Spanish and English.
- » In order to maximize cultural immersion, ISA Sevilla staff members develop develops unique cultural activities. These custom-designed activities invite students to experience the local color of their host city, while learning about the history and culture of their new surroundings. Speaking Spanish with locals, tasting the regional cuisine, and partaking in the native traditions are just a few of the ways these cultural activities lead to full appreciation of the program city.
- » Excursions to Córdoba, Granada, Jerez de la Frontera & Cádiz, Madrid and Toledo are all included in the price of the Summer 2 program.
