Located in the picturesque region of Tuscany, the Montepulciano Summer Study Abroad program provides an opportunity to take six credit hours of coursework in the heart of historic Italy alongside students and faculty from colleges across Georgia.

In addition to living and studying within the medieval walled town of Montepulciano, the program takes advantage of its central location through weekly field trips to Rome, Florence, Siena, Pisa, and other cities.

On the weekends, students are free to explore the wonders of the Italian Peninsula where activities could include swimming the Mediterranean, hiking the Alps, or tasting the creations of this culinary capital, all of which are accessible by bus and rail.


