Exploring Health Perspectives | May 16-30, 2019


This course will integrate concepts from various interdisciplinary fields including nursing, exercise science, athletic training, public health, sport science, outdoor education and physical education. Georgia College students will participate in numerous service learning projects in conjunction with Belizean hospitals, elderly care facilities, orphanages, colleges, local businesses and community centers in and around the area of San Ignacio, Belize. The course will be taught through lectures, seminars, and service learning experiences specially designed for students in the health sciences. Students will be afforded the opportunity to visit a wide range of Belizean historical, archaeological, health and cultural sites throughout the experience. Activities include snorkeling in crystal clear waters, zip lining through the jungle, hiking amidst ancient Maya ruins, caving, kayaking and more!
