PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS: ISA – CUSCO, SUMMER 2

- » The Universidad de Salamanca Cursos Internacionales en Cusco is located at the ISA Study Center, and was developed in partnership with the Universidad de Salamanca to meet the ever-growing interest in studying abroad in Cusco. Students take classes at the study center with other ISA students, and classes are taught by local, visiting and US faculty. All students will receive an official transcript from the Universidad de Salamanca, upon successful completion of the program.
- » In order to maximize cultural immersion, ISA Cusco staff members develop unique cultural activities. These custom-designed activities invite students to experience the local color of their host city, while learning about the history and culture of their new surroundings. Speaking Spanish and Quechua with locals, tasting the regional cuisine, and partaking in the native traditions are just a few of the ways these cultural activities lead to full appreciation of the program city.
- » Excursions to Machu Picchu, Puno & Lake Titicaca and the Sacred Valley are all included in the price of the Summer 2 program. An excursion to the town of Puerto Maldonado in the Amazon rainforest is optional.
